About Fay School Founded in 1866, Fay is the oldest junior boarding school in the U.S. Our 66-acre campus in Southborough, Massachusetts, is just 25 miles from Boston. Our community includes 475 students in K through grade 9, with 150 boarding students who come from more than 25 countries. Students live in family-style dorms on campus, supervised by caring faculty who serve as dorm parents, advisors and athletic coaches. Fay is recognized around the world for its superior educational program, which includes competitive interscholastic athletics and visual and performing arts, and our graduates are accepted to top secondary schools. A highlight is our Creativity and Design Program, where students engage in real-world design projects in partnership with companies like Converse and Bose. For the 2025-26 school year, Fay School awarded over \$5 million in financial aid to over 125 families. fayschool.org

About Middlesex School Middlesex School is an independent boarding and day school founded in 1901 in the historic town of Concord, Massachusetts, only 20 miles from Boston and Logan Airport. Middlesex helps students find their promise through rigorous intellectual, physical, creative, and ethical education. The school sits on 350 acres, serving 425 students in grades 9 through 12. 70% of those students are boarders, representing 22 countries and 33 states. From over 20 Advanced Placement courses to competitive athletics in the Independent School League to robust academics and arts, Middlesex prefers to develop capacities in multiple areas to specialization in one. For the 2024-25 school year, Middlesex provided over \$7.7 million in financial aid to over 135 families. mxschool.edu
